



ATELIER CLARK GUIDELINES / COVID-19 Summer/Fall 2020

Please be advised!

As soon as you leave your home, there is no such thing as zero risk of contact with COVID-19. You need to be aware of this and assume this risk in an informed manner.

The Atelier CLARK is a place where we share knowledge, equipment, and tools. To minimize the risk of spreading COVID-19, the workshop will be equipped with several hand-disinfection stations and, where possible, hand tools and power tools will be disinfected daily. Physical distance of 2 metres between people will also be maintained.

New measures and conditions for using the workshop:

- 1. If you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, have been in contact with someone who is infected with the virus, or have returned from international travel in the past 14 days, please reschedule your visit.**
2. We will limit the number of workshop users to 2-3 at the same time to respect the distance required by Public Health.
3. The space reservation schedule will be implemented very strictly and must be respected by everyone. A reservation that is not honoured (without notifying us at least 24 hours in advance) will be charged.
4. It will be important to carefully plan and estimate the time you will need in the workshop and make the reservation accordingly.
5. There will be two types of shifts: full day and half day (AM/PM).
6. We will no longer provide the service of shared protective equipment (glasses, gloves, ear protection and masks). You will need to bring your own protective equipment.
7. It will be mandatory to have a surgical mask (homemade or other types) with you. The N95 will also do the trick. This is for situations where the 2 meters distance cannot be respected.
8. Manual tools such as drills, screwdrivers, etc. will be dedicated to only one user per shift. It will be your responsibility to disinfect them before and after use. We will provide the disinfectant.
9. In addition to cheques and cash, we will accept Interac transfers.
